FDSA Respect in Sport Policy

<u>Division 1</u>	South West Soccer League ~ 8-12 Game Schedule	Typically teams attend 1-2 tournaments	Top team from region qualifies for Provincials
<u>Premiership</u>	New Brunswick Soccer League ~12 Game Schedule	Typically Teams attend 1-2 Tournaments	Top 4 teams from each league qualify for Provincials



Provincials

- U18 Division 1 Provincials will be August 19th-20th
- ▶ U13 Provincials will be August 26th-27th
- U15 Division 1 Provincials will be August 26th-27th
- U15 and U17 Premiership Provincials will be Sept 2nd-3rd
- Locations for all are TBA



Nationals

- If a Premiership team wins Provincials, they will attend the 2023 Toyota National Championships
- October 4th-9th
- U15s are in Waterloo Region, ON
- U17s are in Moncton, NB



Skills Centre & Academy

Skills Centre for U11

- ▶ 1 Practice session each week
- Opportunity for Skills Centre group to travel and play some games

Academy for U13-U17

- ▶ 1 Practice and 1 Gym session each week
- Opportunity for Academy team group to travel and play some games
- U13 Academy Team, will enter 1-2 additional tournaments and schedule exhibition games against Premiership teams.

Player Selection Roles

Director of Soccer/Division Director

- Ensure balanced selections across age groups
- Manage players "Playing Up" through evaluation and approval
- Monitor individual team's tryout process
- Assist coaches in player evaluation

Coach


- Running a fair and transparent tryout process
- Evaluating all players at tryouts
- Providing appropriate feedback to players during and post tryouts
- Team Selection in conjunction with Club Head Coach

Players

- Be present physically and mentally at tryouts
- Inform coaches of any tryouts they may miss
- Inform coaches of any extended vacation plans for the summer months (more than 2 weeks)
- Give your best effort



Player Selection Criteria





Premiership Tryouts

- Players must be registered online via PowerUp by Monday April 3rd to attend tryouts
 - There will be NO on-site registration at tryouts
- Tryouts will run from April 8th April 16th
- Final team selection by April 17th
- If a player cannot make it to a tryout session, they should notify the coach in advance



Division 1 Tryouts

- Division 1 tryouts run after Premiership tryouts are completed
 - Players not named to a Prem team will be automatically registered to Division 1 tryouts
- Players must be registered online via PowerUp by Saturday April 15th to attend tryouts
 - ► There will be NO on-site registration at tryouts
- Tryouts will run from April 20th April 30th
- Final team selection by May 1st
- If a player cannot make it to a tryout session, they should notify the coach in advance



U13 Foundations Tryouts

- Players must be registered online via PowerUp by Monday April 10th to attend tryouts
 - There will be NO on-site registration at tryouts
- Tryouts will run from April 17th April 30th
- > 3 Boys teams and 3 Girls teams of ~16 players will be selected by coaches through a draft
- Final team selection by May 1st
- If a player cannot make it to a tryout session, they should notify the coach in advance



Underage Players

Philosophy

• In order for a player to play with a team in an older age group there needs to be a significant developmental advantage to the player in question

Process

- FDSA Director of Soccer will manage the process of underage athletes playing up in conjunction with individual team coaches
- Players should discuss their interest in playing up with FDSA Director of Soccer



What if my player doesn't make the team?

- If a player is not named to a Prem team, they will be automatically registered to Division 1 tryouts
- If that player is named to a Division 1 team, they will be refunded the difference between Prem and Div 1
 - They will also be refunded the Academy fee if they choose not to participate in Academy
- If a player is not named to a Division 1 team or a U13 team, they will be automatically registered to the relevant community program and refunded the difference

Family Discount Policy

Families will receive a 'multi-player discount' of \$30/player if they register two or more players in Competitive programs

Example: A family has players registered for U15 Premiership and U13 Foundations

Discount: \$30 + \$30 = \$60



Team Budgets

- Decided on by the teams once selected typically \$150-\$200 per player
 - Coaches' expenses (e.g., tournament travel mileage, meals, etc.)
 - Tournament entry fees
 - Team building activities
 - National Travel Fund Lottery contribution
 - Total expenses are offest by team fundraising activities
- Role of the parent(s)
 - Approve the budget that is presented by coach/manager
 - Discuss any concerns with team manager immediately
 - Ensure team manager shares any major concerns with the FDSA



National Travel Fund

- This fund is maintained to help offset the costs of teams that qualify for Nationals
- The fund is primarily supported through the annual Lottery
 - Premiership players only
 - > \$100 is collected from each Prem player as part of their team fee
 - > \$50 goes to the Travel Fund, \$50 goes to team budget
 - Each player is then given \$100 worth of tickets to sell to recoup the intial investment



Uniforms

- Players will receive:
 - Home and Away Jerseys
 - Black Shorts
 - Black Socks
- \$75.00 uniform deposit will be given to team manager upon receipt of uniform
 - Post-dated cheque which is not cashed unless uniform is not returned or severely damaged
 - We are investigating the possibility that this can be collected as an e-transfer
