

## COACH AND ASSISTANTS CODE OF CONDUCT

## Note: All questions and concerns related to FDSA Codes of Conduct can be directed to the FDSA ED

- I will provide positive support, care, and encouragement for all children participating in FDSA programmes. 1.
- 2. I will encourage good sportsmanship, will support all players, and will encourage each player's developmental potential.
- I will be respectful to all individuals involved in FDSA programmes including players, coaches, game officials, parents, and 3. other members of the public at all games, practices, and events.
- I will encourage players to treat all individuals involved in FDSA programmes with respect including players, coaches, coaches, 4. parents, and members of the public.
- 5. I will always strive to prioritize the emotional well-being of children ahead of any desire to "win".
- I support, encourage, and respect a drug, alcohol, and smoke-free environment for players and all children participating in 6. FDSA programmes.
- 7. I will promote a team-first mentality and will encourage players to attend all games, practices, events, and sessions related to their FDSA programme involvement.
- 8. I will follow proper protocols and channels, as established by the FDSA, related to dialogue pertaining to any issues with coaches, officials, players, and families in a respectful and appropriate manner. I understand that those approved to coach, officiate, and manage are in a position of authority that I must respect. I will respect this authority and follow proper protocols when dialogue is needed.
- 9. I will follow all club policies related to disputes with officials, players, and families.
- 10. I will not be a bystander to, nor participate in, bullying, intimidation, or abuse of any player, coach, official, and /or parent physically, verbally, or emotionally.
- 11. I acknowledge I have a duty to report as is required by law as outlined by the FDSA Code of Conduct to Protect Children.
- 12. I acknowledge that all persons, especially young children and adolescents, have a right to protection from abuse of any kind regardless of their age, gender, ability, culture, language, ethnicity, religious beliefs, and/or sexual orientation.
- 13. I will review, and practice, required coaching techniques and philosophies to appropriately support player development.
- 14. I acknowledge that failure to comply with the above items could result in temporary or permanent removal from the FDSA.
