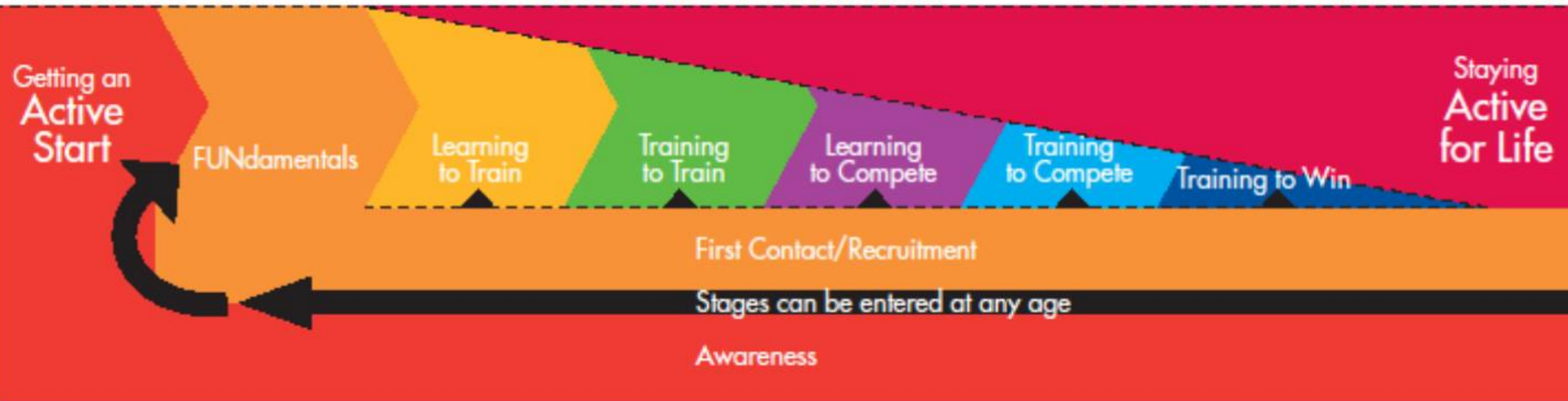

Why Play Competitive?

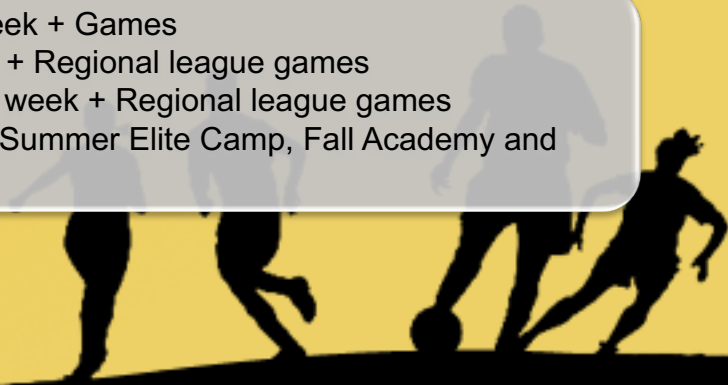
- High quality coaching

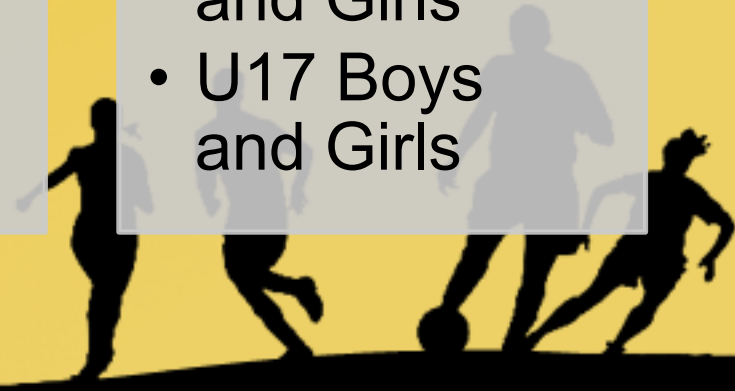

Provincial Champions

U13

- Top 2 Teams at Provincials will attend Atlantic Championship
- Boys PEI and Girls NS
- September 20-23
- 4 Games
- Approximate Budget \$15,000-\$20,000
- Eligible for National Travel Fund ~\$4,000-\$6,000

U15 and U17

- Provincial Champion in each of these age groups qualify for Nationals
- U15 Laval, Quebec and U17 Surry, BC
- October 2nd to 8th
- Approximate Budget \$30,000-\$40,000
- Eligible for National Travel Fund ~\$6,000-\$8,000





Player Selection Roles

Club Head Coach/ Division Director

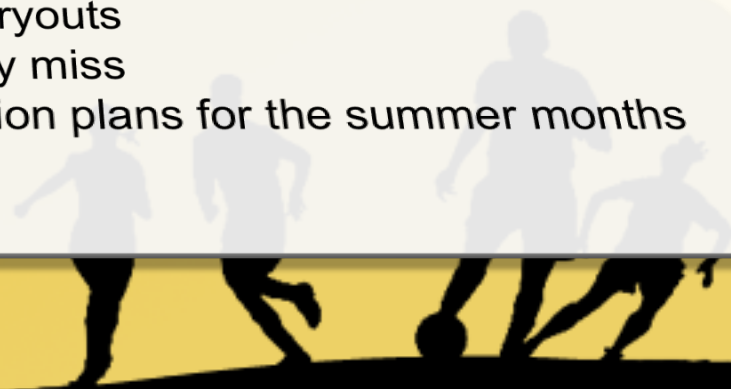
- Ensure balanced selections across age groups
- Manage players “Playing Up” through evaluation and approval
- Monitor individual team’s tryout process
- Assist coaches in player evaluation

Coach

- Running a fair and transparent tryout process
- Evaluating all players at tryouts
- Providing appropriate feedback to players during and post tryouts
- Team Selection in conjunction with Club Head Coach

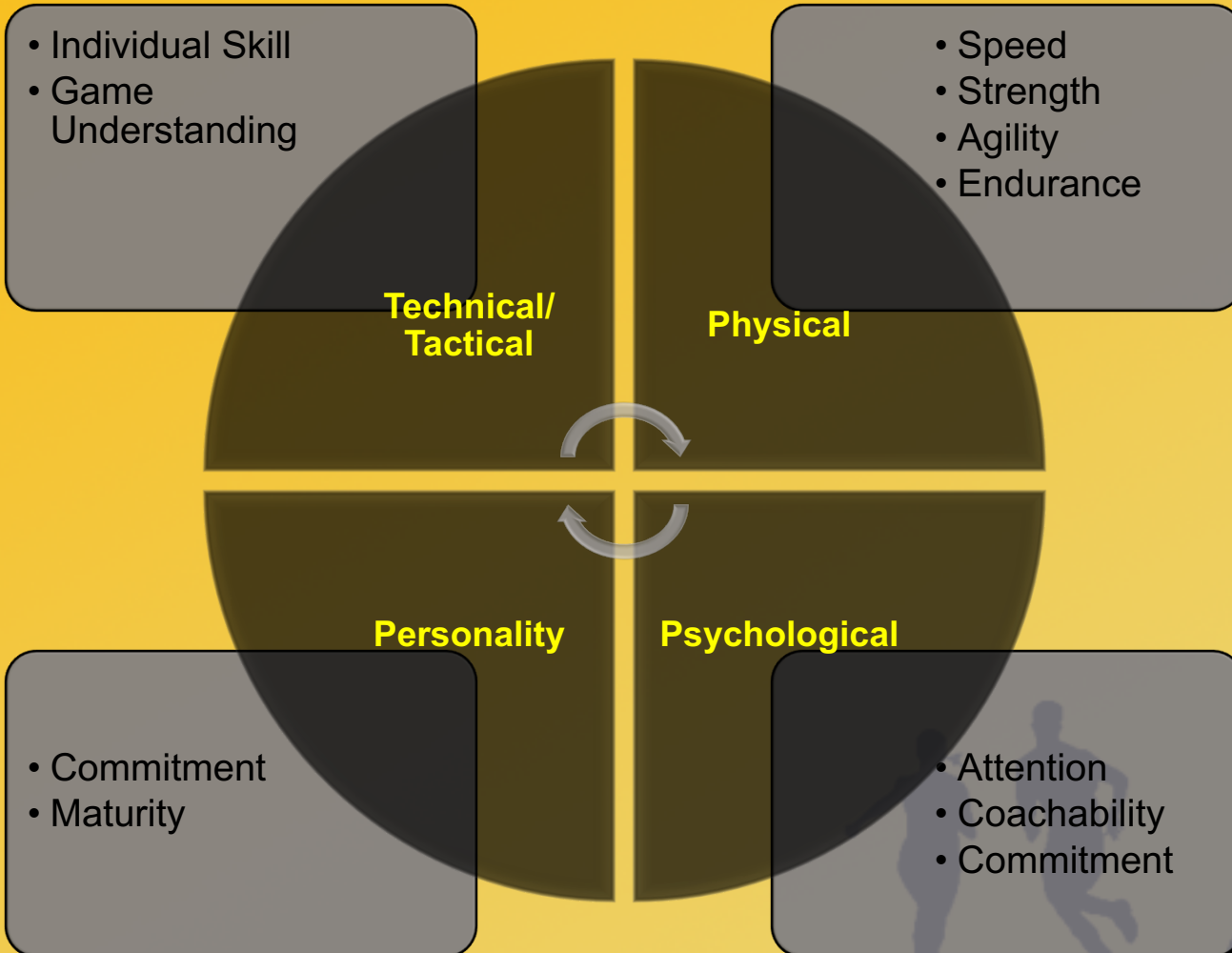
Players

- Be present physically and mentally at tryouts
- Inform coaches of any tryouts they may miss
- Inform coaches of any extended vacation plans for the summer months (more than 2 weeks)
- Give your best effort





Player Selection Criteria





U12 Enhanced Tryouts

- Players **must be** registered online <https://fdsa.powerupsports.com> by Saturday, March 31st to attend tryouts. Tryouts will run April 20th to May 8th
- If a player is unable to make a tryout please notify coaches.
- 4-5 Boys teams of 12-15 players
- 3-4 Girls teams of 12-15 players
- Coaches select players through a draft





Division I Tryouts

- Division I tryouts run after the Premiership
- Players **must be** registered online:
<https://fdsa.powerupsports.com> by Saturday, April 14th to attend tryouts.
- Division I tryouts will run from April 20th – April 30th.
- Final cuts must be made no later than May 1st - may occur sooner than this date.
- If player cannot make a tryout session, notify the coach in advance.
- Check FDSA website daily for changes or updates to the tryout schedule.





Premiership Tryouts

- Register by Saturday, March 31st (no on-site registration the first day of tryouts)
- Only registered players can participate in tryouts
- Register online at <https://fdsa.powerupsports.com> NOW!
- Tryouts will run April 9th – 15th
- Final team selection by April 16th
- Check FDSA website regularly for tryout updates





Underage Athletes

Philosophy

- In order for a player to play with a team in an older age group there needs to be a significant developmental advantage to the player in question

Process

- FDSA Club Head Coach will manage the process of underage athletes playing up in conjunction with individual team coaches
- Players should discuss their interest in playing up with FDSA Club Head Coach





Team Uniform

- Players will receive:
 - Home & Away Jerseys
 - Black Shorts and Black Socks
 - There is a \$75.00 Deposit Required for Uniforms (post-dated cheque, not cashed unless uniform not returned or severely damaged)

Family Discount Policy

Families will receive a 'multi-player discount' of \$45/player if they register 2 or more players in Competitive programs.

Families with 3 or more players in FDSA programs will continue to receive a family discount of \$15/player for recreational programs

Ex. Family has players registered for: U15 Prem, U12 Enhanced & U8 Rec.

Discount: $\$45 + \$45 + \$15 = \105

*Prices include Credit Card convenience fee. If you pay by cash, cheque or debit, the credit card fee will be reversed at time of payment

Premiership

- Base fee (\$324.75) + Soccer NB fee (\$37.50) + Pre-season Camp (\$155.25) + Academy (\$207.00) = \$724.50

Division 1

- Base fee (\$324.75) + Soccer NB fee (\$37.50) + Pre-season Camp (\$155.25) = \$517.50

U12 Enhanced

- Base fee (\$411.75) + SNB fee (\$37.50) = \$449.25

- ALL registrations **MUST** now be completed using this system.
- Payments can also be made in office – 150 Smythe St (online registration must still be completed)
 - Payment Options: Online – Visa or Mastercard ONLY; In-Office – Cash, Cheque, Debit or Credit
 - NOTICE: A convenience fee is now included in all registration fees paid by credit card. To avoid these fees, you can pay in-office by Cash, Cheque or Debit.





What if my child doesn't make the team?

- A player is cut from Premiership they can automatically tryout for Division I; if successful, they will be refunded the Academy fee if they choose not to participate in the Academy.
- A player cut from both Premiership and/or Division I, will be refunded the difference in registration fees between competitive and recreation
- Tryout fee is non-refundable and only charged once





Team Budgets

Typically Included in Budget - \$100-\$200/player

- Coaches Expenses
 - League and Tournament travel (\$.25/km, meals, accommodations)
 - League Expenses
 - Referees (paid by FDSA)
 - Tournament Fees
 - Team Building Activities
 - Team fundraising efforts
- *CSCA gym sessions (~\$75/player) are now included in Academy fee*

Parents Role

- Approve Budget presented by coach & manager
- Discuss major concerns with team manager immediately
- Ensure team manager shares any major concerns with appropriate Program Director





National Travel Fund

- What is it?
- Initiatives to date
- Lottery
 - Each Premiership player is responsible to sell \$100 worth of tickets for lottery (\$100 now collected as part of Team Fee)
 - One half of the proceeds go directly to the Travel Fund (submitted to FDSA by team manager)
 - One half the proceeds go to each team budget reducing the parents financial commitment by \$50 per player (Premiership only)





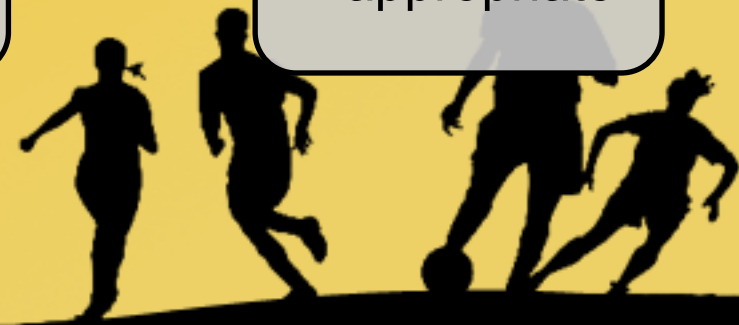
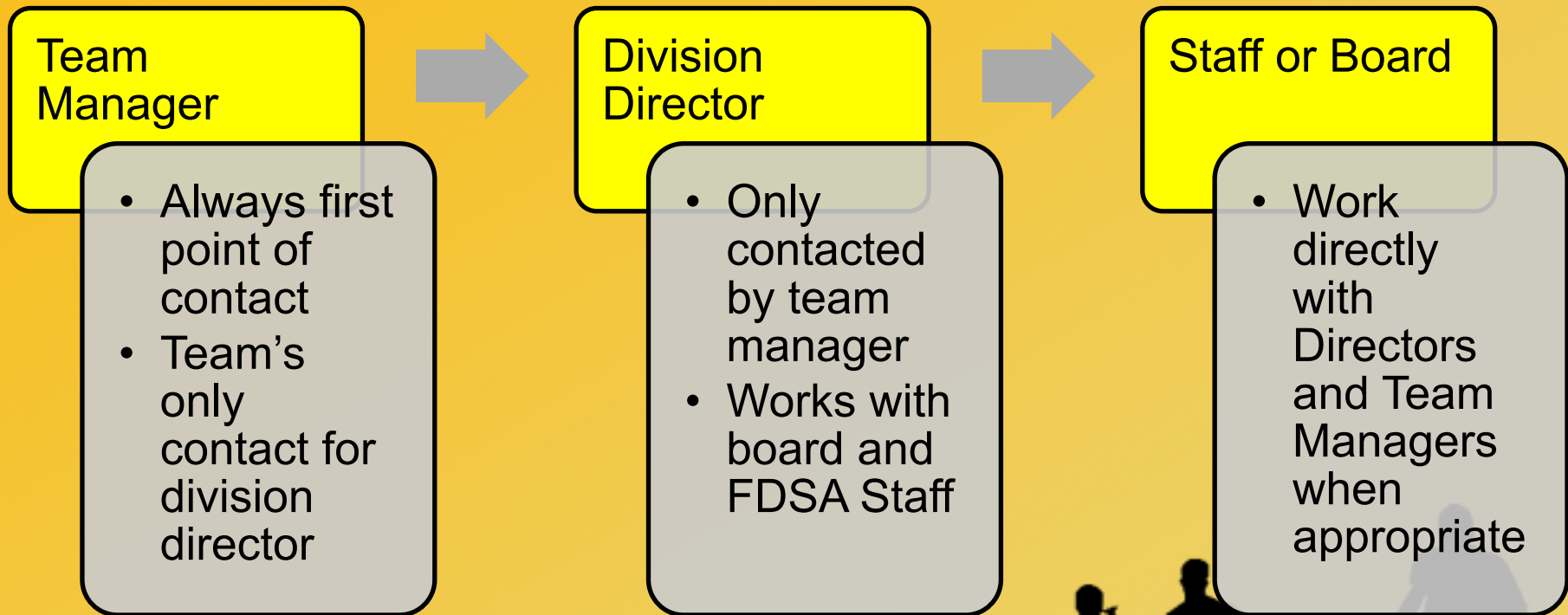
